Training cum interaction prog on Rabi crops

The programme was attended by DTO cum PD ATMA Lohit district M. Chowlu, PTO FTC D. Baman, Debasish Borah, SMS (Agronomy) KVK Lolit,

Chandramoni Singh, SMS (Horticulture), SADO Namsai B. Biswas, HDO Namsai, Farm women of Momong and Chongkham including members from SHGs. The training was conducted in the Momong village and a total of 90 farm women attended the programme with a motto to enhance knowledge of scientific cultivation among

women farmers.
