

## Field day cum cleanliness drive organized

NAMSAI, Oct 27: A field day on “Cross breeding through artificial insemination in improved quality semen” was organized at Alubari village under Namsai district by KVK, Lohit recently.

It was a part of front line demonstration where local cows were inseminated by improved jersey cross and Sahiwal frozen semen. A total of five healthy calves were born so far at Alubari, two male at Namsai and Mahaloni areas of the district.

The subject matter specialists (SMS) of Animal Science described in detail about the technology to the farmers. They further spoke about the importance of the breeding policy through artificial insemination and described the advantages of rearing cross bred cattles.

Subsequently, farmers were also taught about the need of cleanliness. The SMS of Plant Protection specially emphasized the importance of proper utilization of crop residues to make clean of their locality.

Earlier, a mass cleanliness programme was organized as a part of “Swachh Bharat Abhiyan” to clean the community hall cum Mandir of Alubari village by KVK staff and villagers, who also planted numbers of trees and flowers for its beautification.
